**Entry Fee: \$25 per test No charge for 4H members. 4H membership will be verified.** (includes AKC recording and service fees) in US funds to "DONKC, Inc."

**Refunds: If event is cancelled due to COVID, all checks will be destroyed.**

**Prizes: DONKC, Inc.** will award a ribbon to each qualifying dog in each test, and a rosette to each dog titling at this event.

**Eligibility of Dogs to Enter FDC Test.** The FDC test is open to all dogs at least 9 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Clubs may not limit the test to certain breeds except at a specialty club event which is limited to the specialty club's breed or a Group club may limit its event to breeds in its Group. Females in season may not enter. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test. A dog may enter only once per event. An event is defined by an event number.

**Bitches in Season** – Bitches in season will NOT be allowed to participate in accordance with AKC regulations. Refunds with veterinarian's note less \$5.00 processing fee.

**Entries accepted as first received until 30 dog per test limit is reached.**

**If limit is not reached, day of test entries will be accepted**

**This event is at an actively working dairy. PLEASE respect our hosts and their livestock**

**NO FLEXI-LEASES permitted on event grounds.**

**DOGS to be crated if not actually being tested, on deck, or being pottied.**

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. **INSTRUCTIONS**

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

### **FROM I88**

Take **Exit 13**

Turn north and continue on NY 23 W (also NY-205)

At the 6<sup>th</sup> light, there will be a Mirabito's on the left.

Turn left at this light and to stay on NY-23 W for +/- 10 miles

At the light in the village of Morris, turn right onto NY-51 N

Continue 7.8 miles to the destination. You will pass a large dairy barn up close to the road on your right, and the test site is at the next house on the right.

### **FROM UTICA**

Take NY-8 S to Leonardsville (23.2 mi)

Turn left at the light onto Co Rd 19 to NY-51 S/NY-80 W in Burlington Flats (9.2 mi)

Turn right onto NY-51 S (there will be a left turn and then a right in order to stay on NY-51 S)

Drive to NY-51 S in Garrattsville 5.1 mi

If you reach a large dairy barn up close to the road on your left, turn around. The test site is at the next house on the right.
