CLASSES OFFERED

Classes will be **exhibited by breed and by sex**. The best of breed and best of breed puppy 6 to less than 12 months will advance to the respective group and puppy group i.e., Hound, Sporting, Non-Sporting, Terrier, Toy, Herding, Working, and Miscellaneous. Each group winner will advance to the respective Best in Match and Best Puppy in Match. The Junior Handler placing first in each of the Junior Showmanship Breed Classes will automatically advance directly to Best Junior in Match. Puppies and/or juniors that win Best in Breed, will be eligible to advance to Best in Match (in addition to Best Puppy in Match and Best Junior in Match) if undefeated by the regular class dogs.

Breeds will be divided by the following classes:

6 months but under 12 months Puppy

12 months but under 18 months

Open

Junior Novice: Junior handlers 8 but under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class.

The following will be awarded:

Best in Match

Best Puppy (6 but under 12 months) in Match

Best Junior in Match

Parade of Champions: For demonstration purposes only.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, or are recognizable examples of an AKC recognized breed.

- The AKC does not require that a dog be registered to enter Match Shows, but they must clearly represent a purebred breed recognized by the AKC.
- Dogs with points and/or majors towards conformation championship may be entered.
- No dog that is a champion of record may enter except in the Parade of Champions and in the Junior Class as per the AKC Junior Showmanship Rules.
- No dog owned in whole or in part by the Judge or Match Secretary may enter except in the Parade of Champions.
- Professional handlers are permitted to exhibit only those dogs that are wholly owned by them. They may, under no circumstances, handle any other dog for free or for fee.
- Juniors may NOT exhibit a bitch in season as per Junior AKC Showmanship Rules.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible and if exhibited will be dismissed by the judge. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Aggressive dogs or any dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to enter and may be dismissed by the judge.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

The **Handler's Briefing** at the beginning of the day and all exhibitors are expected to be present. The Show Chairpersons will provide some orientation and then the Judges will provide some basic instruction as to her expectations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

No retractable leashes may be used on site at any time.

Indoor crating space maybe limited. Please prepare accordingly.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars & Leashes. Acceptable collars and leads include: slip collar plus lead (loop or snap), slide lead (i.e. rescos), swivel lead, martingale (one piece), and martingale collar plus lead.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. **No retractable leashes to be used on grounds.**

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing due to injury or medical condition will not be eligible for a refund.

Junior Handlers are not permitted to exhibit bitches in season.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

GPS – Use 2483 County Rd 11, Hartwick NY

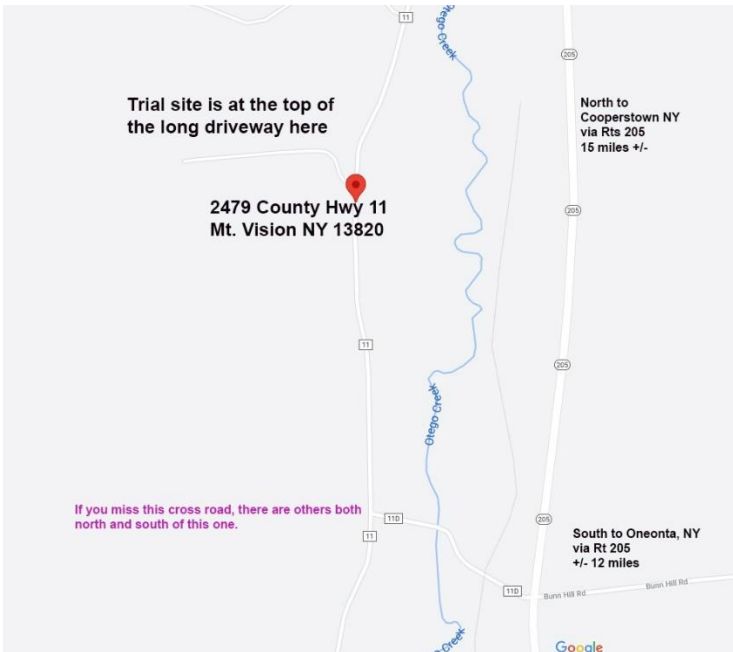
From the North via NYS Thruway: Exit 30, turn left onto NY-28 S/Mohawk St, continue to follow NY-28 S for 19 miles. At intersection of Route 20, continue straight through traffic light onto Co Hwy 25A (0.7 miles). Turn right onto NY-28 S (8.6 miles). Slight right onto NY-205 S/NY-80 W (1.9 miles). Turn left onto NY-205 S (7.4 miles). Turn right onto Jones Crossing Rd (0.2miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn right into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

From Cooperstown, NY: Route NY-28 South, turn right on County Route 11 towards Hartwick (5.8 miles), turn left onto NY-205 S (2.3 miles), turn right onto Jones Crossing Rd (0.2miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn right into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

From the South via I-88: Take exit 13 for NY-205 toward NY-7/Oneonta, turn left onto NY-205 N, continue straight to stay on NY-205 N (11 miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11D (0.3 miles), turn right onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn left into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
