**DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs **SIX (6) months of age** or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

**Condition of the Dog.** Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the Fetch test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

**Bitches in season** may be tested as the last dog(s) at the end of the day. If there are two events on one day, a bitch in season may only be tested as the last dog in the last event. A bitch in season may return if there are events on a second day, and again, be tested as the last dog of the last event at the end of the day. Bitches in season should not be waiting in the area with other dogs.

## ENTRY FEES

\*An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

## MOVE UPS

**MOVE UPS will be accepted** but must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the form available from her **at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the test you wish to be in**, i.e end of day on Saturday for Sunday, or Sunday between tests.

## ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

**Check in with the Trial Secretary at the beginning of each day.**

**Limited crating space will available** outside of the area where they might be a distraction to the dog being tested. If your dog is prone to becoming over excited, loud or disruptive, please consider crating out of your car away from the main building.

Please consider bringing pop-ups for shade and definitely **bring your own chairs**.

Park alongside the driveway and in limited other assigned areas. Leave main driveway open to pass and do not block others in without their express permission.

## NO RETRACTABLE LEASHES

**Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Entries to future DONKC events may be denied on a case by case basis.

## RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying ribbons will be available for those with qualifying scores.

**TITLES** – You will receive the checklist for your dog's run from the trial secretary after each run.  
Upon receiving two (2) qualifying runs under different judges, you may apply to receive a Fetch title.  
Title applications will be available from the Trial Secretary or may be submitted through the AKC title portal online.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

## SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club or any official thereof.

**Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses.** Dogs must wear a collar. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles, or body harnesses. Leashes should be 4 ft. to 6 ft. long and should be made of fabric, leather, or biothane.

## **REFUNDS**

**No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.

**Bitches in season** – See above.

## **RINGSIDE**

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN:** Please check in with Trial Secretary upon arrival. Run order will be posted on site.

**Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."


**DRIVE TO THE TOP OF THE HILL!**

**GPS – Use 2479 County Rd 11, Hartwick NY**

**From the North via NYS Thruway:** Exit 30, turn left onto NY-28 S/Mohawk St, continue to follow NY-28 S for 19 miles. At intersection of Route 20, continue straight through traffic light onto Co Hwy 25A (0.7 miles). Turn right onto NY-28 S (8.6 miles). Slight right onto NY-205 S/NY80 W (1.9 miles). Turn left onto NY-205 S (7.4 miles). Turn right onto Jones Crossing Rd (0.2miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn right into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

**From Cooperstown, NY:** Route NY-28 South, turn right on County Route 11 towards Hartwick (5.8 miles), turn left onto NY-205 S (2.3 miles), turn right onto Jones Crossing Rd (0.2miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn right into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

**From the South via I-88:** Take exit 13 for NY-205 toward NY-7/Oneonta, turn left onto NY-205 N, continue straight to stay on NY-205 N (11 miles), turn left onto Co Rd 11D (0.3 miles), turn right onto Co Rd 11 (0.5 miles), turn left into the driveway, go all the way to the top.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
