DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

As used in these regulations, the word "dog" refers to either sex but only to dogs that are eligible for 11 Regulations Obedience entry in AKC events. Dogs with a PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing), or AKC Canine Partners number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. A dog that is deaf may compete in any obedience trial.

No exhibitor may show a dog under a judge at an obedience trial if the exhibitor has participated in a training session taught by that judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the event. No dog may be entered or shown under a judge at an obedience trial if the dog is owned or handled by any person who has regularly served as a trainer or instructor of that judge, either individually or through classes, or if the dog has been regularly trained or instructed by the judge within ten (10) days prior to the date of the obedience trial. "Trained or instructed" applies equally to judges who train professionally or as amateurs and to judges who train individual dogs or train or instruct dogs in classes with or through their handlers (see "Glossary of Terms").

ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday, September 2, 2026, 6:00 p.m. EST at the Trial Secretary's address. All entries received before the opening date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed. No entries will be accepted by personal delivery, phone, email, or fax.

CONFIRMATIONS AND JUDGING SCHEDULES WILL BE SENT BY EMAIL unless otherwise requested.

RALLY ENTRY FEES – EACH TRIAL (Includes \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee)

First entry of a dog in Rally	\$30.00

Reduced fee for additional entry applies only to a dog entered in two or more Rally classes in the same trial.

Trial Secretary will add a \$32.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Dogs listed with the AKC Partners Program should mark breed as "All American Dog" or "Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed dogs.

Transfers are permitted as provided for in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the obedience regulations.

A wait list will be maintained for these trials.

Rally Trials will be held **OUTDOORS UNDER A PAVILION, ON MATTING**.

Classes will be judged in jump height order, from small to large, for all trials.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Faxed, emailed, telephoned, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries Not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

Make Checks and Money Orders payable to Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club Inc. **CANADIAN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry.

An AKC Recording Fee of 50¢ first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience Trial. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry only and \$3.00 for each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. All Recording Fees and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

No Entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause which is beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: SITE GUIDELINES

The Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club is committed to providing an environment that allows exhibitors and dogs to compete with minimal distraction. The following site regulations **shall apply to all exhibitors** and **will be enforced** throughout the trial:

1. PAVILION USE

- **Pavilion #1**, located closest to the parking lot, **shall be used for exhibitor crating and practice**. Dogs may be crated and practice **only** in Pavilion #1 and walked **only** in the area adjacent to Pavilion #1.
- **Pavilion #2** is **restricted to club members, volunteers, and their dogs**. The **only** other dogs permitted in Pavilion #2 are the **dog currently exhibiting** and the **dog on deck**. Exhibitors wishing to practice, play with, or exercise their dogs **must do so well clear of Pavilion #2**. Failure to comply may result in the exhibitor being **required to leave the trial grounds**.

2. FOOD

- **Food will not be provided on-site**. Exhibitors are responsible for making their own arrangements.

3. LEADS AND CONTROL

- **Flexi-leads are not permitted** anywhere within Fortin Park.
- **Off-leash practicing is prohibited** anywhere within Fortin Park.

4. CLEAN-UP

- Exhibitors **must clean up after their dogs**. Failure to do so **may result in future entries being refused**.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
2. Dogs listed in the **AKC CANINE PARTNERS Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION.
